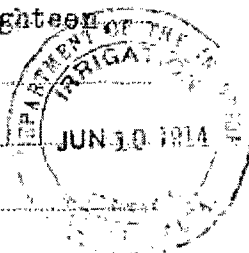

First Issued on the 11<sup>th</sup> June 1914

Know all men by these presents, that by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Irrigation Act, I, the Honourable William James Roche, M.D., Minister of the Interior of Canada, do hereby grant unto The Town of Bassano, in the province of Alberta

hereinafter called the licensee, their successors, administrators and assigns, full right, power and license, subject to the conditions and restrictions contained in the Irrigation Act, to divert from Bow river at a point on the Blackfoot Indian Reserve in township twenty one, range eighteen west of the fourth meridian



the following quantity of water for "other" purposes as hereinafter specified and described, viz: - a system of waterworks for domestic and fire protection in the town of Bassano

.....through the works  
constructed by the licensees

.....as shown by the application of  
the said licensees

dated the 7th day of December, 1912,  
and the plans in connection therewith, <sup>filed</sup> dated the 27th day of February, 1913,  
and as amended on the 28th day of August, 1913; 16th April,  
1914, and 18th May, 1914.  
and filed in the Department of the Interior, at Ottawa, and in the Office of the Commissioner  
of Irrigation and Chief Engineer, in the city of Calgary, in the Province of Alberta, and as

authorized by the Honourable the Minister of the Interior on the.....22nd day of.....

May, 1913 that is to say: 581 acre feet of water during each year, -to be diverted at highwater and flood stages of the stream only, at the following rates:

At flood level.....cubic feet per second.

At high water.....cubic feet per second.

At low water.....cubic feet per second.

And to take and keep possession of the said quantity of water for and during the period during which this license may be in force under the provisions of the Irrigation Act.

But this license shall be subject to the following conditions, viz. :

(1) That the period of flood level, high water and low water in the said Bow river

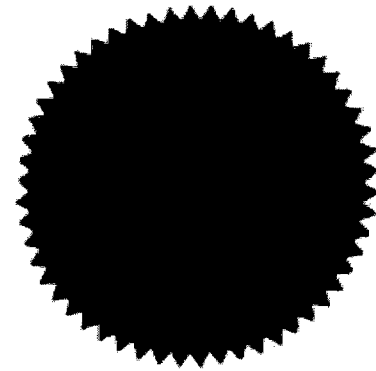
shall be fixed and determined by marking on the Gauge Rod placed in the said stream by the Department of the Interior.

(2) That this license shall be subject to forfeiture under and as provided by the Irrigation Act.

(3) That this license can only be assigned or transferred with the approval of the Minister of the Interior, and by using the form printed on the back thereof, and that such transfer must be recorded in the Office of the Commissioner of Irrigation and Chief Engineer, in the city of Calgary, in the Province of Alberta, and the old license surrendered for cancellation. before a new license will be issued in the name of the transferee.
