## **SPRING CLEAN-UP**

On Tuesday May 22, 2018 the Town of Bassano will be facilitating a yard waste Spring Clean-up to assist residents in disposing of excess yard waste. Residents can dispose of yard waste by bagging it in Clear plastic bags only and leaving the bags in the back alley for the town crew to collect. This program is strictly limited to **YARD WASTE ONLY**. All bagged yard waste must be placed in the alley by 7:00am May 22.

Council has passed first reading on a new proposed Traffic Bylaw (876-18). Changes to the Bylaw include proposed reduction in speed to 40 km/hr within Town limits unless otherwise posted and changes to off highway vehicle use.
