

BYLAW 810/08

OF THE TOWN OF BASSANO IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A Bylaw of the Town of Bassano, in the Province of Alberta, to provide for the appointment of chief elected official by Council from among the councillors.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26 RSA 2000, Part 5, Section 150, provides that a Council may pass a bylaw requiring Council to appoint the chief elected official from amongst the Councillors,

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 150 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26 RSA 2000, the Council of the Town of Bassano, in the Province of Alberta, in Council duly assembled, enacts as follows:


1. That the Chief Elected Official of the Town of Bassano shall be appointed by Council from among the Councillors.
2. That the appointment shall be made by Council at their Organizational Meeting to be held not later than two weeks after the third Monday in October.
3. That the appointment shall be effective annually at the Organizational Meeting of Council.

This bylaw shall come into effect upon the date of final reading.

READ A THIRD TIME IN COUNCIL AND PASSED THIS 8th DAY OF December, 2008
