Things to remember...

Business License

A per Bylaw 832/12 all businesses that operate within the Town of Bassano require a license. Obtain your license and you will (if you wish) be part of the Town's Business Directory that is published online and in print.

If you have a contractor working on your property inquire to see their license. If they do not have one please direct them to the Town Office to avoid fines.

Dog and Cat Licensing

Renew or register your dog or cat at the Town Office. Every cat and dog in Bassano must be licensed according to the Cat Control Bylaw 837/12 and Dog Control Bylaw 836/12. Licenses are issued in January and expire on December 31st each year. If you have three (3) to a maximum of four (4) dogs a fanciers license will be required at an additional cost.

Garbage Bins reminder

- Garbage must be bagged and must fit in your bin with lid closed.
- Bins need to be placed with the arrows on the lid, pointed towards the street or avenue.
- Garbage placed on or beside the bin will not be picked up.
