BYLAW NO. 852/14
Road Closure Bylaw
of the

TOWN OF BASSANO
In the Province of Alberta

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BASSANO FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND DISPOSING OF PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC ROADWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, CHAPTER M-26, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and whereas an application has been made to Council to have the roadway closed, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Bassano deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof situated in the said municipality, and thereafter disposing of same, and

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act; and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Bassano in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and disposing of the following described roadway, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

1. That portion of 8th Avenue adjacent to the lands legally described as Block 30, Plan 4437 AD and Block 31, Plan 4437 AD that lies between 1st Street East and 2nd Street East and that portion of laneway that lies between 1st Street East and 2nd Street East;
2. All of Playfair Street adjacent to the lands legally described as Block 30, Plan 4437 AD and Block 31, Plan 4437 AD that lies between the northern boundary of the lands legally described as Block Z, Plan 4437 AD;

All within SW ¼ Sec. 20-21-18 W4M and shown in Schedule 'A' as attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
