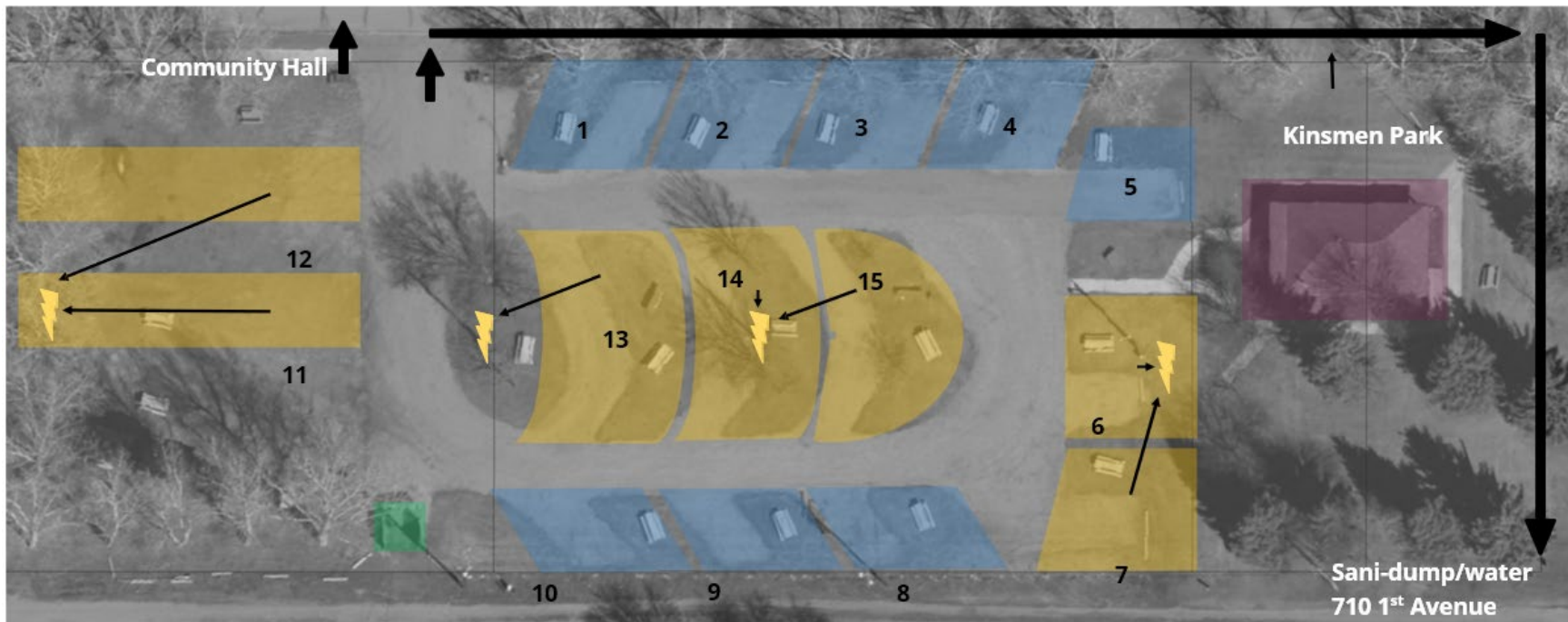




BASSANO HOMECOMING CAMPGROUND

The campground is located at 605 - 2nd Avenue directly across the street from the Bassano Community Hall making it excellent for out-of-town guests attending functions. **Sites are available on a first come first served basis.**

Follow arrows from campground entrance to the sani-dump and the coin operated potable water station located in front of public works shop at 710 1st Avenue.

Campground Rates

- Power Sites = \$25/night
- Non-power sites = \$20/night
- If you have a large RV/camper and wish to stay in a power site only one power hook up can be used. If you need another power hook up, you will be charged for two power sites. Refer to the campground map for power.
- Each tent and unit are considered a separate camper.
- Check out time is 1:00 p.m.

Registration

Option 1 – Register in person at the Bassano Town Office during regular business hours. Monday – Wednesday and Friday from 9:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. 502 – 2nd Avenue.

Option 2 – We accept payment by Interact e-transfer, or Visa/Mastercard over the phone during regular business hours. Call 403-641-3788.

Option 3 – We accept online Interact e-transfers.

1. Set up Town of Bassano as a payee using town@bassano.ca as the email address.
2. Include your site number in the comment field with your e-transfer.
3. You will not be required to provide a password as the funds will be automatically deposited into the Town of Bassano's account.

Option 4 – We accept cash and cheque in the drop box at the campground. Cheques must be made payable to the **Town of Bassano**. *Payment methods 1-3 are preferred.*

Welcome to Our Campground

Quick facts to assist you during your planned stay.

Q1: Can we reserve campsite(s) or book ahead?

No, we do not accept reservations. We run our campground on a first come, first serve basis.

Q2: Are fires permitted?

Wood firepits are not permitted in the campground. Only portable, self-contained propane fire pits are permitted. Remember to check for fire bans.

Q3: Are there picnic tables?

Yes. You are only permitted to use the picnic table at your registered site.

Q4: What time is quiet time?

In accordance with Town bylaws, quiet time is 11:00 p.m. – 7:00 a.m. Please be considerate of others.

Q5: Can I bring my pet/dog to the campground?

Yes! In accordance with Town bylaws, you must keep your pet on a leash and pick up any fecal matter.

Q6: Are there washrooms and shower facilities on site and open to users?

Yes, showers and washroom facilities are open and available free for campers.
