# BUILDING, DEVELOPMENT, AND CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

# **BUILD Bassano - Residential Vacant Land Development Incentive**

The Town offered for sale land under fair market value to promote residential development in Bassano. Anyone that purchased the land has 6 months to submit their development plans for approval. Failure to do this would result in forefitting the lands back to the Town.

Five lots are being recovered. Four lots due to a failure to submit required development plans, and one because of an appeal regarding the proposed development of a 4-plex. With opposition to the 4-plex, investors could justify the capital costs of a single unit dwelling regardless of an approved development permit. All remaining lots sold under this program have approved development permits.

There is a waitlist for some of the lots being recovered.

# **BUILD Bassano 2024 Development Project Update**

The four part project has publicly tendered and awarded to the lowest bidder, Bullin Construction Co. Ltd. at \$1,153,500.59 (including GST) at the July 29, 2024 council meeting as recommended by MPE Engineering. The project includes

- 1. PART I Demolition and Site Remediation of 822 5A Avenue
- 2. PART 2 5A Avenue Triangle servicing 4 infill lots
- 3. PART 3 Large Lot Subdivision (South of Tracks) 12 lots
- 4. PART 4 Airport Subdivision 11 lots

The Town is awaiting final approval on aspects of the project from Alberta Environment and Protected Areas. Upon receipt of approvals contruction will begin. The project is fully funded by reserves providing varied types/sizes of lots for residential growth in Bassano. A Request for Proposals (RFP) is being sought for realtor services. The RFP closed on September 3, 2024. Submissions will be considered by council at the September 18, 2024 meeting starting at 6:30 p.m. in the chambers.

Reports were received that the **Bassano Off-leash Dog Park** has been well used so far this summer. A lot of volunteer time has gone into this park and cleaning up the underutilized greenspace. Be sure to get out and enjoy this space with your furry friend!

### **RECYCLING IN BASSANO**

You may have noticed in change at the recycling depot located at 702 – 1 Avenue. A new partneship was formed with Newell Regional Landfill and Newell Recycling that supported the retirement of the BARRA and a more cost effective way to recycle.

Cardboard and paper will remain at this location. Electronics and tin will be relocated to the Bassano Transfer Station.

Large commercial cardboard users must make alternate arrangement with Newell Regional Landfill for their recycling needs.

## **REMEDX Redemiation Services Inc. (Application No. 001-500888)**

RemedX has applied to Alberta Environment & Protected Areas for an approval to construct and operate a new Class II Industrial Landfill north of Bassano within the County of Newell SW 4-23-18W4M. A directly affected person may provide input into certain regulatory decision as allowed by Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act (section 73). A person(s) who is directly affected by the application may submit a written statement of concern within 30 days of the date of notice (originally posted on August 15, 2024) to:

# What are the localized impacts of a new Class II Industrial Landfill?

Newell Regional Landfill (NRL) (the regional and municipally owned facility in Brooks) is a Class II landfill and accepts industrial waste. The construction of a new, privately owned Class II landfill has the potential to divert industrial waste away from the NRL. The diverted material (mainly contaminated soils) is revenue producing for NRL. It is also used for approved landfill operations. A change in industrial revenues may impact solid waste rates for municipal partners. Industrial waste revenues are currently allocated to lower the municipal waste requisitions.

The possible quantity of industrial waste diversion has not been confirmed but it is anticipated by the NRL board and it's management.

A big thank you goes out to the Western Communities Foundation, Bassano Royal Purple, and the Bassano Rural Fire Protection Association for their generous donations to our facility. These donations funded 3 free swims, 3 fun days, new youth lifejackets, a sunshade for patrons lounging in the grassy area, new white lounge chairs, lifeguarding weights, and a new pool basketball net!



Very busy summer! A total of 6476 patrons attended our facility from June 1<sup>st</sup> to August 28<sup>th</sup>. That is 1000 more patrons than last year!
